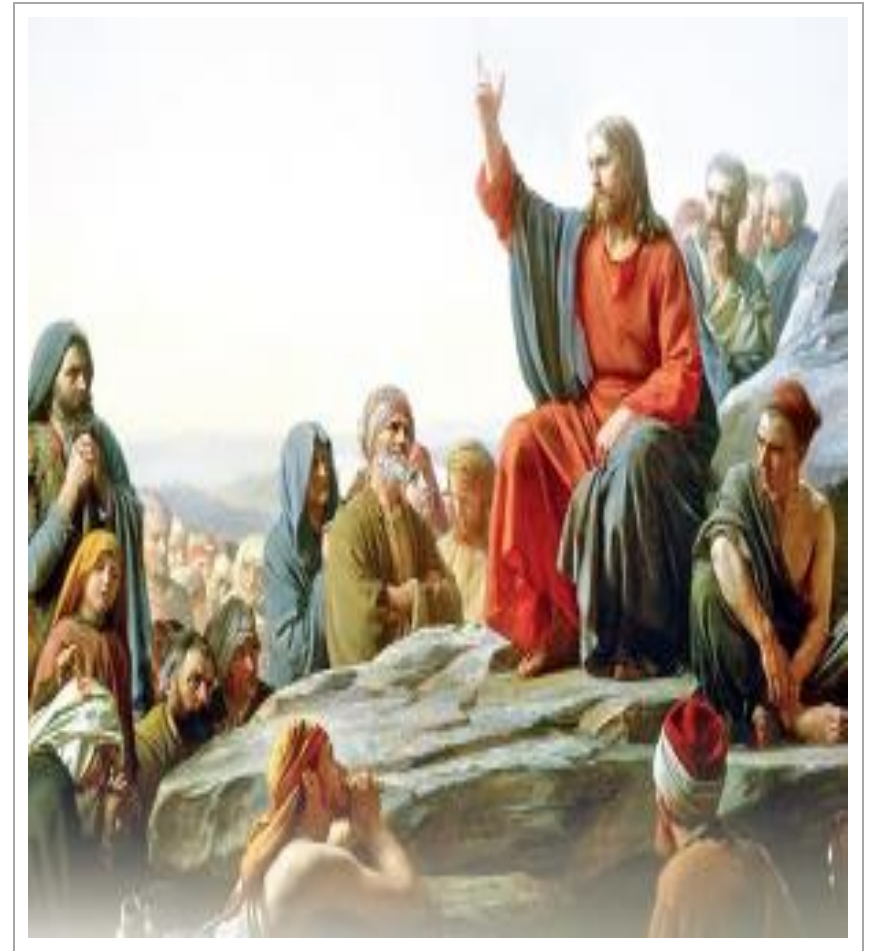

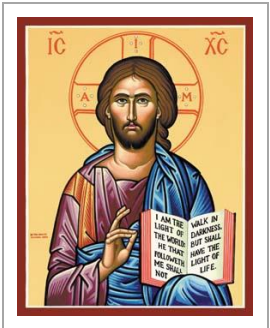
Faith Formation Retreats & Conferences

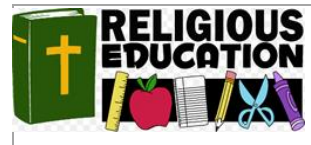
Programs Overview

Sacramental Preparation



Preparing children, youth and adults to receive the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, First Communion, Confirmation and the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA / RICA), and the vocation of Marriage.

Elementary Religious Education (E.R.E.)



Elementary Religious Education (ERE) is Faith Formation classes for children of 1st year of First Communion prep, and post First Communion. ERE classes are broken down by grade to target age-appropriate learning and activities.

Youth Ministry



Youth Groups provide adolescents and Young adults the opportunity to further develop their Catholic faith and bring Christ into the community through service projects:

Junior Youth Ministry (JYM) – Post-First Communion on Sundays

Young Adults – single young men and women of 18 y/o and up.
